

Associate Director Qualifications

The role of an Associate Director is a collaboration between this group, the Board of Directors and the Sr. Management Team and assists in promoting the benefits of Credit Union membership. These individuals act as ambassadors for the organization and promote the products, services and financial education of the credit union. We expect them to bring to the group a broad range of knowledge and experience from their chosen business or profession, as well as promote the values and principles of Leominster Credit Union within the communities we serve.

An Associate Director should be willing to share their views openly to assist in identifying ways to enhance the products and services the credit union provides, as well as educating potential members about the benefits of using a credit union.

Requirements

- Member, or willing to become a member, of the credit union
- Ability to comply with all appropriate policies
- Minimum Age: Must be 21 years of age or over
- Has not had a membership in any credit union which has been terminated, other than voluntarily
- Credit Standing: Must not be in arrears more than one (1) month in payments due the credit union on any indebtedness
- Must be a resident of Massachusetts and a citizen of the United States
- Bondability: Must qualify for bonding
- No Criminal Record: No felony convictions or pending felony charges
- Not a current employee of the Credit Union

Desired Expertise and Experience

The objective is to achieve an overall balance of required skills and expertise in the individuals that serve as Associate Directors. Specific expertise in these areas will be considered positive attributes of potential candidates, recognizing that not all candidates will present these characteristics.
